Meeting Minutes  
September 21, 2009

**Anita Brown**, President, called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm in the band room at Shepton High School.

**Karen O'Donnell**, Plano West Band Booster President, asked the Shepton Band Boosters to volunteer for the October 17 UIL Competition that is being hosted this year by Plano West. Shifts are from 11:00 am to 9:30 pm with multiple positions available. Karen listed the 11 positions offered and answered questions. Shepton band students will need to be at Shepton by 12:45 pm and will return at 6:30pm. National (Junior) Honor Society hours can be earned that day as well. There will be a training meeting on Thursday, October 15, at 7:00 pm. Volunteers will get into the competition free.

**Anita** stated there were no minutes to review since this was our first Band Booster meeting of the school year. No Treasurer's report was presented.

**Ruby Gibke**, Spaghetti Dinner Co-Chair, updated the Board on the event. The caterer will be Buca di Beppo. For \$3,000 plus a \$25 delivery fee, Buca di Beppo will cater for 600 adult and 100 children's meals (based on last year's numbers). An Adult meal is spaghetti with 3 oz. of sauce, one meatball, Caesar salad, bread and butter. A Child's meal is spaghetti with meat sauce, Caesar salad, bread and butter. Frankford and Renner parents will provide the desserts (like last year). The Gibke family will donate the lemonade and iced tea. Starbucks at Park and the Tollway will donate the coffee again. Ruby is waiting on a quote from Quick Print (the printer PISD uses) for the placemats/programs. If anyone knows of a printer that might be willing to donate the printing, please contact Ruby. (Ms. Murphy said she had a contact and would talk to Ruby after the meeting.) Ruby has reserved the cafeteria, library and open area outside of the library and is looking for help in determining how many tables to request (silent auction, check-in, ticket sales, etc.) Please contact Joy Allington-Baum directly to volunteer for this event. We really need everyone to make this event a success!

**Liz Hairston**, Silent Auction Chair, reminded everyone of the November 1 deadline for all Silent Auction items. Each section of the band is putting together a Silent Auction item, too. Silent Auction ideas were discussed.

**Anita** presented ideas for the Raffle prizes: big screen TV, a gaming system, and a GPS. Everyone agreed with these prizes.

**Anita** and **Ms. Murphy** updated the Boosters on the Pie Sale. The vendor is Red Wheel and each student will be asked to sell seven or eight pies. The fundraiser includes pies, cheesecakes and breakfast braids. The Pie Sale will begin November 21 at the Spaghetti Dinner and run through December 4. Delivery date will be December 16.

**Lauren Charbonneau**, Scrip Co-Chair, explained how the Scrip program works and, depending on the gift cards purchased, Band Boosters earn eight to nine percent of the dollars sold. This year we will be doing online purchases only.

**Sharla Stack**, Spirit Chair, announced the lockers would be decorated this week.

**Amy Bullington**, Passbooks Co-Chair, said she and **Candy Waller**, Passbooks Co-Chair, were tracking down the last of the unreturned Passbooks.

**Marlys Bratton**, Directory Chair, reminded everyone to please review their student's information in the Directory Draft that was being routed to the members during the meeting. Parents were to make any changes and sign the draft.

**Anita** reiterated the importance of going onto CHARMS frequently for the latest in rehearsal times and recent pictures.
